This brief activity has been used to introduce students to School Travel Planning. Each of these pages includes a visual depiction of an action that students can include in their action plans. Students (individually or in a group) are asked to guess what activity is being depicted in the image. They are then also asked to answer the 3 questions underneath each image; (1) what is going on, (2) why do this activity, and (3) how could this work at our school? Once they have a few minutes to think, they are asked to explain the action to the whole group.

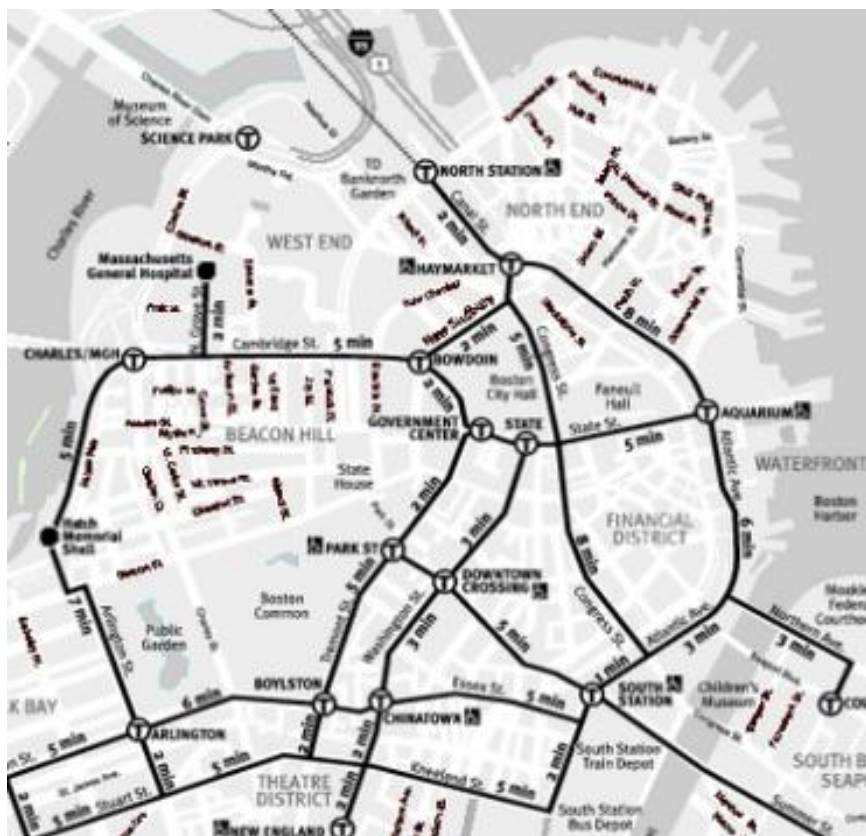
